MEDIA ACCREDITATION INFORMATION

Eligibility for media accreditation

Media are encouraged to attend and report on WILD9, the 9th World Wilderness Congress, but will require prior accreditation. Accreditation is strictly reserved for bona fide members of the media - print, photo, radio, TV, film, online and news agencies - who fully meet WILD9 media accreditation requirements.

Deadline: Requests for media accreditation must be received by October 20, 2009.

Accreditation procedures

- Complete [online accreditation form](#)
- Attach scanned or PDF photocopy of:
 - Letter of assignment on official letterhead of a media organization signed by the Publisher/Assignment Editor, Editor-in-chief or Bureau Chief, specifying the name and functional title of the journalist.
***Unsigned letters or e-mails will not be accepted.
 - Valid press card/work pass
 - Passport/national ID card
- Send completed form and attachments to media@wild9.org
- Upon approval, you will be sent instructions to register for WILD9.

Freelance journalists, including photographers, are subject to the same requirements and must provide a valid assignment letter from a specific news organization or publication.

Media accreditation is not accorded to the information outlets of non-governmental organizations.

Requests for accreditation can be denied if applicants cannot establish they are professional journalists or if applications are incomplete.

Applicants will receive a response from WILD9 within 7 working days after receipt of applicant's application.
